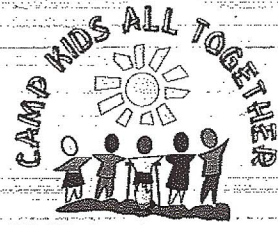

What Is Kids All Together?

Kids All Together is an award-winning inclusion program that offers children and teens with special needs the opportunity to participate fully in children's and teen programming at the Jewish Community Center of Metropolitan Detroit. Programs include:

Preschool/Kindergarten Inclusion: Young children with special needs are matched with an advocate who supports the student in a preschool or kindergarten classroom at the Sarah & Irving Pitt Child Development Center.

Summer Day Camp Inclusion: Children and teens grades Pre-K through 9 with special needs are paired with specially trained inclusion counselors who support campers in their daily activities so they can fully participate in the Center Day Camps.

Sports & Recreation Break Camp Inclusion: Children grades K through 5 with special needs are paired with specially trained inclusion counselors who support campers in their daily activities so they can fully participate in the Sports & Recreation Break Camps.
